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# 2024 NORTH CAROLINA FIRE PREVENTION SCHOOL

#### **General Information**

The Sixty-Third North Carolina Fire Prevention School will be held March 18 - March 22, 2024 at the Courtyard Marriott, Carolina Beach. The Fire Prevention School is presented by the NC Association of Fire Chiefs and Cape Fear Community College. The on-site school check-in will begin on Monday, March 18, 2024, at 11:00 a.m. and the school will conclude at noon Friday, March 22, 2024.

<u>Monday's Schedule:</u> at the Courtyard Carolina Beach, at 100 Charlotte Avenue, Carolina Beach, North Carolina 28428.

- \*Fire Prevention School check-in begins at 11:00 a.m. 12:30 p.m.,
- \*Fire Prevention School opening session begins at 12:30 p.m. and continues to 5:00pm.

The topic of the afternoon will be Energy Storage Systems presented by NEMA. <u>The afternoon sessions are part of the Fire Prevention School and attendance is required.</u>)

All other classes will begin at 8:00 a.m. Tuesday – Friday. Attendance in all classes and class functions is required for course credit.

#### ALL STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BE ON TIME FOR EACH CLASS PROMPTLY AT 8:00AM

The Fire Prevention School's philosophy has always been to offer competency-based instruction, whereby, the student is exposed to a broad base of material going beyond the requirements of the fire code. With this in mind, students should not be subjected to a duplication of the certification classes but will receive more in-depth study on related topics.

Four courses make up the North Carolina Fire Prevention School including Basic (General), Intermediate (General/Technical), Advanced (Advanced/Technical). These classes are required for graduation from the Fire Prevention School. Students should plan to take the three courses in succession regardless of their position in their jurisdiction. A Graduate class is offered for those that complete the three main courses.

The 2024 NC Fire Prevention School is limited to 160 students with no exceptions.

Early registration is a must to secure your seat in the school and the option to select your t-shirt size.

#### **Course Information**

<u>Basic (General)</u> - this course will offer general information on the General Fire Precautions, Building Code for the Fire Code Official, Electrical Hazards, Means of Egress, Motor-Fuel Dispensing Facilities, and others. It is designed for the novice inspector or for the experienced inspector who seeks an update on Fire Code requirements. **Students should bring a copy of the 2018 Building Code and Fire Code with NC Amendments.** 

<u>Intermediate (General/Technical)</u> – this course offers the student a mixture of general and technical information. It will provide information from the code and will address material used daily by the Fire Inspector. Topics include Breweries & Distilleries, Interior Finishes & Decorations, Fire Alarm Systems, Fire Service Features (Chapter 5), Alternative Fire Suppression Systems, and others.

<u>Advanced (Advanced Technical)</u> - this course offers the student a look at more advanced technical information. Topics include Flammable Finishes, Fire Sprinkler Plans Review, Rough-In & Final Inspections of Sprinkler Systems, Smoke Control Systems, High Piled Combustible Storage, School Inspections, and others.

<u>Graduates (Advanced Technical/Managerial) -</u> this course offers the student a look at more advanced technical/managerial information. Topics include Interaction between code officials, Emergency Responder Radio Communication Systems, Building Code Council/Ordinance Adoption, General Assembly Organization – Legislative Updates, and others.

#### **School Information**

The current IFC Fire Prevention Code with NC amendments will be the primary text; the NC Building Code with NC amendments will be used, and the NC Administrative Code will be referenced. The code books will not be available on the premises. Please contact the NC Department of Insurance, Engineering Division, at telephone (919)-647-0001 for information on ordering a code book. Class participants will need to bring their code books.

All available class presentations will be made accessible for download following the school.

On **Thursday night**, there will be a cookout for all students followed by a one-hour class on topics of current interest. This class will allow students to further discuss code enforcement topics and issues not covered in the daytime classes. The cost of the cookout is included in the registration. **If you plan to bring a guest to the cookout, an additional fee of \$20.00 will requested and tickets will be available at the Opening Session.** 

#### **Lodging Information**

Students are responsible for their own reservations and should note during registration that they are attending the Fire Prevention School. The Courtyard Marriot will be the hosting hotel.
